#### Introduction

# Port health organisation, Chennai:

The Port Health Organisation came into existence in pursuance of The Indian Port Health Rules, 1955 framed under The Indian Ports Act ,1908. The Port Health Organisation, Chennai primarily is a Public Health Organisation. It is located at Rajaji Salai, Chennai-600001. Port Health Officer (PHO) works under the overall control of the Director General of Health Services (Dte.GHS), Govt. of India, stationed at the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Nirman Bhawan, Delhi. The DGHS in turn is assisted by DDG (International Health) and ADG (International Health). The PHO is assisted by other staff details of which are given below. The objective of Port Health Organization is to prevent the international spread of disease which can affect international trade & travel, and to ensure a safe environment (Food Safety, Water Safety and General Hygiene & Sanitation) in the port.
